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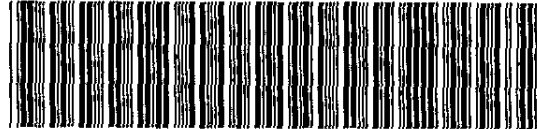

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of said corporation shall be **Regina's House for Women, Inc.**

SECOND: The place in Florida where the principal office of the corporation is to be located at **701 W. Lake Brantley Road, Altamonte Springs, Fl. 32714.**

THIRD: The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(a) To receive and maintain real or personal property, or both and subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(C)(3) of the IRC code and its regulations as they now exist or they may hereafter be amended. More specifically, these purposes shall include but not limited to:

(1) To maintain a residential or halfway house for rehabilitating young adults between the ages 18-50 years old, that have problems such as marriage, personal, alcohol and drug abuse.

(2) To motivate young people adults to live victorious lives through meetings, recreation, and Christian teaching and instruction.

(3) To promote moral character and self-esteem among the youth and adults.

(4) To combat juvenile delinquency and adult literary.

(B) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article three hereof.

(C) Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or adequately providing for all the debts, obligations, and liabilities of the Corporation, distribute the remaining assets of the Corporation exclusively for the nonprofit religious purposes shall distribute the remaining assets of the Corporation to such organization or organizations which are tax exempt under section 501(C)(3) of the Code, as amended, as the Board of Directors in its

sole discretion shall determine. The extent of personal liability, if any, for directors, officers, or members for corporate obligations and the methods of enforcement and collection, are as follows: NONE. Further, the Directors and Offices shall be exempt from liability and/or indemnified from costs and judgments to the full extent permitted by Florida law. In the event the (your state) law is subsequently amended to authorize the further elimination or limitation of the liability of Directors or Officers of nonprofit corporations, then the liability of Directors and officers of the corporation in addition to the limitation on person liability provided under this Article, shall be limited to the fullest extent permitted by such later amended by Florida law.

FOURTH: The boards of directors were appointed by the president.


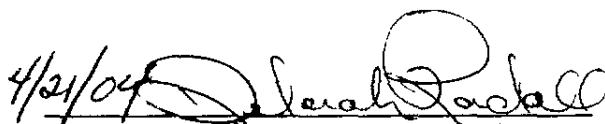
