ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE GUNNALLEN FOUNDATION, INC.

THE UNDERSIGNED INCORPORATOR, desiring to form a non-profit corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, does hereby certify as follows:

<u>ARTICLE I - NAME</u>

The name of this corporation shall be:

The Gunn Allen Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address of the initial principal office and the mailing address of this corporation is:

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The corporation is a private foundation, organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV - NO PECUNIARY PROFITS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inner to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

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ARTICLE Y - ACTIVITIES

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any fature federal tax code, or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. This corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE VI - DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VII - MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Except as otherwise required by law, directors of this corporation shall be elected or appointed in the manner provided in the bylaws of this corporation.
