

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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
RESTORATION OF LIFE CATHEDRAL, INCORPORATED**

In compliance with the requirements of Florida Statutes Chapter 617, the undersigned, acts as incorporator, and adopts the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing and forming such corporation (the "Corporation") as follows:

**ARTICLE I
Name**

The name of the Corporation is:

**ARTICLE II
Principal Office**



This is Not for Profit, Religious, Charitable and Educational Corporation is organized for the following purposes:

Prohibited Activities:

No part of the earnings of "Restoration of Life Cathedral Incorporated," shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay a reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles of incorporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) and any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a charitable and educational not for profit corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Distribution Upon Dissolution:

The dissolution of Restoration of Life Cathedral Incorporated, can only be done by the express will of the Apostolic Council, decree of Court, or bankruptcy. In such a case, all efforts shall be terminated and all assets shall be liquidated in order to satisfy creditors. All remaining assets will be donated to other not for profit corporations by the appropriate State of Florida court in Palm Beach County, Florida.
