ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

THE BLUEBERRY FIELD HOUSING COUNSELING CORP.

The undersigned, for the purposes of forming a <u>Florida's nonprofit corporation</u> under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of the corporation is THE BLUEBERRY FIELD HOUSING COUNSELING CORP.

ARTICLES II Principal Office

The principal office and mailing address of this corporation is 2038 Betsy Drive, Jacksonville, FL 32210

ARTICLES III

Purpose

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

- 1. To provide housing counseling and charitable assistance to low-to moderate-income renters, homeowners and homeless;
- 2. To help homeowners eschew foreclosure and renters to abstain from eviction;
- 3. To assist first time home buyers obtain affordable housing and eligible renters locate and qualify for assisted rental units;
- 4. To assist homeless persons to find the transitional housing they need to move toward a permanent place to live;
- 5. To invest in property rehabilitation for resell to first-time homebuyers and low-to moderate income persons;

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organization under



section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The services of this corporation shall be carried out through officers, employees, licensed real estate agents in the State of Florida. and volunteers.

ARTICLES IV Manner of Election

The directors shall be elected every three years by the Board of Directors and shall hold office until their successors are respectively elected and qualified. Each director shall cast one vote per candidate, and may vote for as many candidates as the number of candidates to be elected to the board. The candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected to serve on the board.

Elections of directors need not be by ballot.

ARTICLE V Initial Directors

The number of initial directors of this corporation shall be three and the names and addresses of the initial directors are as follows:

ARTICLE VIII By-Laws

ARTICLE 1V **Director Compensation**

Directors shall serve without compensation except that a reasonable fee may be paid to directors for attending regular and special meetings of the board. In addition, they shall be allowed reasonable advancement or reimbursement of expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. Any director of the corporation may also serve the corporation in any other capacity and receive compensation in any form.

ARTICLE V1 Indemnification

The Board of Directors is hereby specifically authorized to make provision for indemnification of directors, officers, employees and agents to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE VII Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
