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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this Corporation is THE L. W. COOPER EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The Corporation shall be organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes within the meanings of § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended (the "Code") and § 617.0301 of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, as now in effect or as may hereafter be amended (the "Act").

In furtherance thereof, the Corporation may receive property by gift, devise or bequest, invest or reinvest the same, and apply the income and principal thereof, as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine, either directly or through contributions to any charitable organization or organizations, exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes.

MANNER OF ELECTION

Thereafter, the Directors shall be elected at each annual meeting of the Members and each director shall hold office until the next annual meeting of Members and until the director's successor has been elected and qualified, or until the director's earlier resignation or removal from office.

INDEMNIFICATION

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ARTICLE XI

ACTION BY DIRECTORS OR SHAREHOLDERS WITHOUT A MEETING

The directors or members of this Corporation may take action by written consent as provided by law.

ARTICLE XII

DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution or final liquidation of the Corporation, all of the remaining assets and property of the Corporation shall, after paying or making provision to: the payment of all of the liabilities and obligations of the Corporation and for necessary expenses thereof, be distributed to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under § 501(c)(3) of the Code as the Board of Directors shall determine. In no event shall any of such assets or property be distributed to any member, director or officer, or any private individual.

ARTICLE XIII

SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to any director or officer of the Corporation, or any other private person, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to or for the Corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise permitted by § (((H04000126190 3)))

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501(h) of the Code and in any corresponding law of the State of Florida), and the Corporation shall

not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements concerning)

any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

During such period, or periods, of time as the Corporation is treated as a "private

foundation" pursuant to § 509 of the Code, the directors must distribute the Corporation's income

at such time and in such manner so as not to subject the Corporation to tax under § 4942 of the

Code, and the Corporation is prohibited from engaging in any act or self-dealing (as defined in

§4941(d) of the Code), from retaining any excess business holdings (as cefined in §4943(c) of the

Code) which would subject the Corporation to tax under § 4943 of the Code, from making any

investments or otherwise acquiring assets in such manner so as to subject the Corporation to tax

under §4944 of the Code, from retaining any assets which would subject the Corporation to tax

under § 4944 of the Code if the directors have acquired such assets, and from making any taxable

expenditures (as defined in § 4945(d) of the Code).

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation

shall not directly or indirectly carry on any activity which would prevent it from obtaining

exemption for Federal income taxation as a corporation described in § 501(c)(3) of the Code, or

cause it to lose such exempt status, or carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on by a

corporation, contributions to which are deductible under § 170(c)(2) of the Code.
