# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

### ARTICLE I - DURATION

The name of this corporation shall be: Eglise Evangelique de la Divinite Chretienne, In ... ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The corporation is a not for profit corporation, organized specifically and primarily to solicite, collect, accumulate, administer, receive and maintain real and personal property, or both, in whatever form, including cash funds from public and private sources, and, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth: to use and apply the whole or any part of the income there from, and the principal thereof, exclusively for religious, charitable, or religious education purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code and the regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may herafter be amended.

(b) This Corporation shall not, as a substantial parts of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise, in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
