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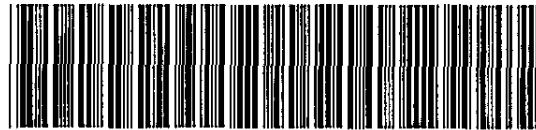



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FLORIDA OUTDOORSMAN ASSOCIATION, INC
A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

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ARTICLE ONE
Name

The name of the Corporation is FLORIDA OUTDOORSMAN ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE TWO
Principal Office and Address

The address of the principal office of the corporation is 502 W. Green Street, Perry, Florida 32347, and the mailing address of the corporation is the same.

ARTICLE THREE
Duration

The term of existence of the Corporation is perpetual and the corporate existence will commence on the filing of these articles by the Department of State.

ARTICLE FOUR
Purpose

The corporation is a not for profit corporation. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(a) To operate for the advancement of the conservation of fish and wildlife and to promote the freedom and opportunity of Florida citizens to enjoy outdoorsman activities, by the distribution of its funds for those purposes, and particularly for providing a statewide forum for all outdoorsmen, addressing their needs and promoting the benefits of outdoorsman sporting activities such as hunting and fishing as lifetime recreational activities through:

(b) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for charitable, and educational purposes which will qualify it as an exempt organization under 26 U.S.C.A. § 501(c)(3), or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for those purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations under that Section.

(c) This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.


