ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION Of The American Health Coalition, Inc.

The undersigned hereby forms a corporation not for profit under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes (the "Corporation") and, for these purposes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I—NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be THE AMERICAN HEALTH COALITION, INC.

ARTICLE II—PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is:

ARTICLE III—PURPOSES

The purpose of The American Health Coalition, Inc. is to improve American and global quality of life by promoting lifespan healthy lifestyles. It shall act as a catalyst to enhance collaboration, coordination and communication among local, state, national and international health agencies, organizations and policymakers.

The specific purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

- a) Reduce obesity, HIV/AIDS and substance abuse
- b) Eliminate health disparities
- c) Enhance access to quality care
- d) Increase workforce diversity in health professions

ARTICLE IV—MANNER OF ELECTION
