Addendum to Articles of Incorporation

ARTICLE III

- 1) Caribbean Children Nutrition Health Education Center Inc. is organized for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the promotion, publicity and the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 2) The Foundation's purpose will be to help impoverished children and youth in Haiti. Our main objective is to improve the life conditions of poor and malnourished children. We will help them with their nutritional needs by providing them food, enriching their knowledge by providing educational materials so they can attend school, and seeing that they get the proper medical needs to maintain their health.
- The foundation may engage in a variety of fundraising activities, including, but not limited to, associated events such as charity dinners, silent auctions, and raffles with the general public. It is anticipated that the Foundation will distribute most, if not all, of its assets on an annual basis. The entities to whom the Foundation makes donations will be chosen entirely in the discretion of the Board of Directors of the Foundation

ARTICLE IX – NO PRIVATE INUREMENTS; <u>RESTRICTIONS ON ACTIVITIES</u>

- 1) No part of the net earnings of the Caribbean Children Nutrition Health Education Center Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to it's members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.
- 2) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate public office.

3) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, Caribbean Children Nutrition Health Education Center Inc. shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the code or (b) by the organization's contributions which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE X: DISTRIBUTION UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction in Florida exclusively for such purposes as the court shall determine.
