## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF AGAPE INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY, INC.

#### A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I: CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is Agape International University, Inc.

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation is 2099 West Prospect Road

Ft. Lauderdale, Florida 33309

ARTICLE III: TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV: NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

This Corporation is not organized for profit or organized in an activity ordinarily carried on for profit, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

#### ARTICLE V: PURPOSES

The purposes for which this University was organized are:

- To educate the whole man, spiritually, mentally, physically and socially with emphasis up the spiritual development, sound doctrinal interpretation, and the academic vocations for ministry and leadership.
- To educate students in the post-secondary studies of Christian education, ministry, music, clinical counseling, leadership, church administration and multimedia.
- 3. To grant to students completing their studies at Agape International University Associate degrees, Bachelor degrees, Master's degrees, Doctorate degrees, and

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- professional certificates upon the completion of their degree programs. These degrees shall have a religious modifier.
- 4. To make available descriptive materials to the community of sound doctrinal practices.
- 5. To integrate the study of the Bible as the revealed will of God into the total curriculum.
- 6. To prepare students better for service to their Creator and to humanity.
- 7. To prepare an environment wherein biblical principles of behavior are taught, promoted and exemplified.
- 8. To provide an environment wherein students develop the social and cultural skills necessary to good citizenship and competent, caring human interactions.
- 9. To provide an environment wherein all students may pursue the realization of their full intellectual potential.
- 10. To promote the development and practice of group and individual problem solving skills.
- 11. To provide opportunities for students to develop qualities of leadership, cooperation, creative thinking and responsible behavior.
- 12. To encourage and promote evangelization of the world.
- 13. To encourage and promote the worship of God.
- 14. To encourage and promote the edification of believers.
- 15. To provide a basis of fellowship among Christians.
- 16. To encourage the development of healthy congregations.
- 17. To examine candidates for the ministry and to ordain as ministers those who shall meet the requirements of this fellowship.
- 18. To provide clinical supervision for Christian counseling.
- 19. To provide supervised practical experience in vocations of the ministry.
- 20. To provide a basis for support group formation and fellowship.
- 21. To provide training for faith based organizations to serve the community.

22. To stimulate international acquaintance and fellowship.

#### ARTICLE VI: MEMBERSHIP

The membership of Agape International University shall consist of the following:

- 1. Voting Members, as per by-laws.
- 2. Advisory Members, as per by-laws.

#### ARTICLE VII: MEETINGS

1. Annual Meetings

The Board of Directors shall meet annually. The exact time and place of such meetings shall be determined by the Board of Directors.

2. Quarterly Meeting

The Board of Directors shall meet quarterly. The exact time and place of such meetings shall be determined by the Board of Directors.

3. Special Sessions

Special Sessions may be called upon by agreement of the Board of Directors, as the occasion demands.

### ARTICLE XIV: ANY ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CORPORATION

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements, any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or to be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or any private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on:

- (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 50l c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or
- (b) by a corporation, contribution, to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE XV: EFFECTIVE DATE

The incorporation of the Agape International University, Inc. shall become effective September 16, 2004.
