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ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION OF MIAMI CHINESE WELFARE COUNCIL, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under the Non-profit Corporation Law of the State of Florida, do hereby certify:

FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be MIAMI CHINESE WELFARE COUNCIL, INC.

SECOND: The place in Florida where the principal office is to be located is 1750 W. Flagler Street, Miami, FL 33135.

THIRD: Said corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code. Specifically, the Corporation is organized to operate a charitable service center for the benefit of new immigrants and senior citizens, and provide counseling services for new immigrants and activities center for senior citizens.

FIFTH: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidates for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

SIXTH: Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purpose of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization in or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or sciences as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding provision of any future federal income tax code), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

SEVENTH: The method of elections of directors will be stated in the Code of bylaws. The number of Directors, shall be no less than three. The number of Directors may be changed from time to time by resolution of a majority of the Directors present in person, or by proxy at any regular meeting, or at any special meeting called for that purpose
