#### **Brief Description of Agency**

The National Council for the Preservation of Black Families (NCPBF) is a voluntary nonprofit membership organization that strives to achieve and maintain a high quality of life for Black families. The NCPBF utilizes advocacy and community-based programming to promote the following:

- 1. Positive Black family values
- 2. Effective Black parenting practices
- 3. Functional Black family relationships
- 4. Home environments for Black children that yield positive emotional, intellectual, spiritual, and physical child development
- 5. Development of community supports to assist Black families in need
- 6. Preservation of focus on Black families as the fabric of Black communities

#### **Projects and Activities**

- 1. National Centers for Black Families
  - <u>Mother-Daughter Bonding Centers</u> community-based programming that promotes good health, self-awareness, spirituality, personal freedom, physical/psychological fulfillment, self-confidence, and close bonds between young girls and positive women role models.
