We, the undersigned, pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, certify that the following Charter of First Circuit Trial Lawyers, Inc., was approved by the Board of Directors and then was duly

of the members present, the following Resolution: BE IT RESOLVED, that the First Circuit Trial Lawyers, Inc. reads and provides as follows:

ARTICLE I: NAME

Section 1. The name of this corporation shall be: FIRST CIRCUIT TRIAL LAWYERS, IN

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

Section 1. The principal office shall be at 905 East Hatton Street, Pensacola, Florida 32503.

ARTICLE III: OBJECTIVES AND GOALS

- Section 1. The objectives of this corporation are to:
 - (a) Uphold and defend the principles of the Constitutions of the United States and the State of Florida.
 - (b) Advance the science of jurisprudence.
 - (c) Train in all fields and phases of advocacy.
 - (d) Promote the administration of justice for the public good.
 - (e) Uphold the honor and dignity of the profession of law.
 - (f) Encourage mutual support and cooperation among members of the bar.
 - (g) Diligently work to promote public safety and welfare while protecting individual liberties.
 - (h) Encourage the public awareness and understanding of the adversary system and to uphold and improve the adversary system, assuring that the courts shall be kept open and accessible to every person for redress of any injury and that the right to trial by jury shall be secure to all and remain inviolate.

ARTICLE IV: MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Membership in the First Circuit Trial Lawyers, Inc. shall be open to all persons who meet the qualifications for membership as set forth in the Bylaws.

Section 2. Membership in the First Circuit Trial Lawyers, Inc. shall be on a yearly basis by invitation extended under the direction of the Board of Directors in accordance with the Bylaws of this corporation.

ARTICLE V: DURATION

Section 1. This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved according to law.

Section 1. The business and property of the First Circuit Trial Lawyers, Inc. shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of:

- (b) Four (4) or more others to be elected from the membership as provided in the Bylaws.
