Appendix A to Brain Injury Resource Group, Inc. Florida Articles of Incorporation In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S. (Not for Profit)

Article III Purpose: The primary and specific purpose of the corporation is to-create a Web-based information and educational center for survivors and caregivers of adults with mild to moderate traumatic or acquired brain injuries, and for other general charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code (IRC). The corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted by tax-exempt organizations under the IRC, nor participate in any substantial way in any political campaigns or attempt to influence legislation or carry-out propaganda. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, director, trustee, or officer of the corporation, or any private individual, except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation affecting one or more of its purposes, and no member, director, trustee or officer of the corporation, or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation. Upon the dissolution of the corporation or the winding-up of its affairs, the assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively to one or more charitable, religious, scientific, testing for public safety, literary, or educational organizations, which would then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the IRC and its Regulations.
