ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FISHERMAN'S COVE OF LEE COUNTY COMMONS ASSOCIATION, INC. (A CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT)

In compliance with the requirements of the Laws of the State of Florida, and for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, the undersigned does hereby acknowledge:

- Name of Corporation. The name of the corporation is FISHERMAN'S COVE OF LEE COUNTY COMMONS ASSOCIATION, INC. ("Association").
- <u>Principal Office.</u> The principal office of Association is 14200 A&W Bulb Road Fort Myers, Florida 33908 or such other location as shall be designated by the Board of Directors.
- Registered Office Registered Agent. The street address of the Registered Office of Association is 1833 Hendry Street, Fort Myers, FL 33901. The name of the Registered Agent of Association is: Christopher J. Shields
- <u>Definitions</u>. A declaration entitled Declaration of Restrictions and Covenants for Fisherman's Cove Commons (the "Declaration") will be recorded in the Public Records of Lee County, Florida, and shall govern all of the operations of a community to be known as Fisherman's Cove Commons. All initially capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the Declaration.
- Purpose of Association. Association is fanned to: (a) provide for ownership, operation, maintenance and preservation of the Common Areas and improvements thereon; (b) perform the duties delegated to it in the Declaration; (c) administer the interests of Association and the Owners; and (d) promote the health, safety and welfare of the Owners.
- Not for Profit. Association is a not for profit Florida corporation and does not contemplate pecuniary gain to, or profit for, its members. Board of Directors, or officers.
- Powers of Association. Association shall, subject to the limitations and reservations set forth in the Declaration, have all the powers, privileges and duties reasonably necessary to discharge its obligations, including, but not limited to, the following:
- To perform all the duties and obligations of Association set forth in the Declaration, these Articles, and the By-Laws.
- To enforce, by legal action or otherwise, the provisions of the Declaration, these 7.2. Articles, and the By-Laws and the rules, regulations, covenants, restrictions and/or agreements governing or binding Association and the Fisherman's Cove Commons.
- To fix, levy, collect and enforce payment, by any lawful means, of all Assessments payable pursuant to the terms of the Declaration, these Articles, and the By-Laws.
- To pay all Operating Costs, including, but not limited to, all licenses, taxes or 7.4. governmental charges levied or imposed against the Common Areas or other property of Association and establish reserves for deferred maintenance or capital expenditures.
- To acquire (by gift, purchase, or otherwise), annex, own, hold, improve, build up an, 7.5. operate, maintain, convey, grant rights and easements, sell, dedicate, lease, transfer or otherwise FISHERMAN'S COVE COMMONS - ARTICLES

dispose of real or personal property (including but not limited to the Common Areas) in connection with the functions of Association except as limited by the Declaration.

- To borrow money, and to mortgage, pledge or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money or debts incurred.
- To dedicate, grant, license, lease, concession, create easements upon, sell or transfer all or any part of, the Common Areas to any public agency, entity, authority, utility, or other person or entity for such purposes and subject to such conditions as it determines and subject only to requirements in the Declaration, if any.
- To participate in mergers and consolidations with other non-profit corporations organized for the same purposes.
- To adopt, publish, promulgate or enforce rules, regulations, covenants, restrictions or agreements governing Association, the Common Areas, Parcels and Units as provided in the Declaration and to effectuate all of the purposes for which Association is organized.
- 7.10. To have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a not-forprofit corporation organized under the Laws of the State of Florida may now, or hereafter, have or exercise.
- 7.11. To employ personnel and retain independent contractors to contract for management of Association and the Common Areas as provided in the Declaration and to delegate in such contract all or any part of the powers and duties of Association.
- 7.12. To contract for services to be provided to, or for the benefit of. Association, Owners, and the Common Areas as provided in the Declaration such as, but not limited to. Telecommunication Services, maintenance, garbage pick-up, and utility services.
 - 7.13. To establish committees and delegate certain of its functions to those committees.
- 7.14. To hold all funds and property owned or acquired by the Association in the name of the Association for the benefit of its members in accordance with the provisions of the Declaration, these Articles, and the By-Laws.
- 8. <u>Voting Rights.</u> Owners and Developer shall have the voting rights set forth in the By-Laws.
- Board of Directors. The affairs of Association shall be managed by a Board of odd number with not less than three (3) nor more than five (5) members. The initial number of directors shall be three (3). Board members shall be appointed and/or elected as stated in the By-Laws. The election of Directors shall be held at the annual meeting of the members. Directors shall be elected for a term expiring on the date of the next annual meeting. The names and addresses of the members of the first Board who shall hold office until their successors are appointed or elected, or until removed, are as follows:

- 10. <u>Dissolution</u>. In the event of the dissolution of Association other than incident to a merger or consolidation, any member may petition the Circuit Court having jurisdiction of the Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida for the appointment of a receiver to manage its affairs of the dissolved Association and to manage the Common Areas, in the place and stead of Association, and to make such provisions as may be necessary for the continued management of the affairs of the dissolved Association and its properties.
- 11. <u>Duration</u>. Association shall have perpetual existence.
- 12. Amendments.
- 12.1. General Restrictions on Amendments. Notwithstanding any other provision herein to the contrary, no amendment to these Articles shall affect the rights of Developer unless such amendment receives the prior written consent of Developer, which may be withheld for any reason whatsoever. No amendment shall be effective until it is recorded in the Public Records.
- 12.2. Amendments Prior to the Turnover Date. Prior to the Turnover Date, Developer shall have the right to amend these Articles as it deems appropriate, without the joinder or consent of any person or entity whatsoever. Developer's right to amend under this Section is to be construed as broadly as possible. In the event that Association shall desire to amend these Articles prior to the Turnover Date, Association must first obtain Developer's prior written consent to any proposed amendment. Thereafter, an amendment identical to that approved by Developer may be adopted by Association pursuant to the requirements for amendments from and after the Turnover Date. Thereafter, Developer shall join in such identical amendment so that its consent to the same will be reflected in the Public Records.
- 12.3. <u>Amendments After the Completion Date.</u> After the Turnover Date, but subject to the general restrictions on amendments set forth above, these Articles may be amended with the approval of two-thirds (66 2/3%) of the Board.

13. <u>Limitations.</u>

- 13.1. <u>Declarations is Paramount.</u> No amendment may be made to these Articles which shall in any manner reduce, amend, affect or modify the terms, conditions, provisions, rights and obligations set forth in the Declaration.
- 13.2. <u>Rights of Developer</u>. There shall be no amendment to these Articles which shall abridge, reduce, amend, effect or modify the rights of Developer.
- 13.3. <u>By-Laws</u>. These Articles shall not be amended in a manner that conflicts with the By-Laws.
- 14. <u>Incorporator.</u>

15. Officers. The Board shall elect a President, Secretary, Treasurer, and as many Vice Presidents, Assistant Secretaries and Assistant Treasurers as the Board shall from time to time determine.

- 16. <u>Indemnification of Officers and Directors.</u> Association shall and does hereby indemnify and hold harmless every Director and every Officer, their heirs, executors and administrators, against all loss, cost and expenses reasonably incurred in connection with any action, suit or proceeding to which such Director or Officer may be made a party by reason of being or having been a Director or Officer of Association, including reasonable counsel fees and paraprofessional fees at all levels of proceeding. This indemnification shall not apply to matters wherein the Director or Officer shall be finally adjudged in such action, suit or proceeding to be liable for or guilty of gross negligence or willful misconduct. The foregoing rights shall be in addition to, and not exclusive of, all other rights to which such Director or Officers may be entitled.
- 17. Transactions in Which Directors or Officers are Interested. No contract or transaction between Association and one (1) or more of its Directors or Officers or Developer, or between Association and any other corporation, partnership, association, or other organization in which one (1) or more of its Officers or Directors are officers, directors or employees or otherwise interested shall be invalid, void or voidable solely for this reason, or solely because the Officer or Director is present at, or participates in, meetings of the Board thereof which authorized the contract or transaction, or solely because said Officers' or Directors' votes are counted for such purpose. No Director or Officer of Association shall incur liability by reason of the fact that such Director or Officer may be interested in any such contract or transaction. Interested Directors shall disclose the general nature of their interest and may be counted in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the Board which authorized the contract or transaction.
