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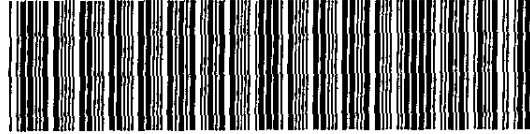

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

PALM BEACH NICARAGUAN COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes related to Nicaraguan youths and scientific dealings. Including in such purposes are the making of distributions to the organization that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section at any future federal tax code.

Prohibitions:

No part of the net earnings of this organization shall ensure to the benefits of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth by this organization. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The organization shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office not withstanding any other. The organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on

- (a.) By a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code or
- (b.) By a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE XII EFFECTIVE DATE


The effective date of this corporation shall be November 15, 2004.


