## RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR NATIVA HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC.

The Articles of Incorporation for Nativa ("Articles") are recorded in Official Records Book 18168, Page 1048 of the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

## RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR NATIVA HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC.

A Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation

The original Electronic Articles of Incorporation were filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida. Nativa Homeowner's Association, Inc. hereby adopts the following Restated Articles of Incorporation to supersede and replace entirely the original Articles.

#### **ARTICLE I- NAME**

The name of the corporation is: NATIVA HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC., hereinafter referred to as the "Association."

#### ARTICLE II- ADDRESS

The principal place of business address is: 112 Nativa Circle, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33410.

The mailing address of the corporation is: 112 Nativa Circle, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33410.

#### **ARTICLE III- PURPOSE AND POWERS**

The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is: For the purpose of providing an entity under FS 617 for the operation of a neighborhood homeowners association in Palm Beach County, Florida known as Nativa Homeowner's Association, Inc. The Association is further organized for the purpose of operating, governing, administering, and managing the

property and affairs of the Association and to exercise all powers and discharge all responsibilities granted to it as a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, as may be amended from time to time, the Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions for Nativa as may be amended from time to time, these Articles, the Bylaws and to otherwise operate in its capacity as a homeowner's association for the use and benefit of the Association's members. It is not intended that the Association have any net income. The operation of the property and affairs of the Association are incidental to the operation of Nativa.

#### **ARTICLE IV- DIRECTORS**

The affairs and property of this Association shall be managed and governed by a Board of Directors composed of not fewer than three (3) no more than seven (7) directors. The first Board of Directors shall have three (3) Directors, and the number of Directors on subsequent Boards will be determined from time to time in accordance with the provisions of the Bylaws of the Association. All directors shall be members of the Association and must be members in good standing with the Association.

Directors shall be elected by the voting members by a plurality of the votes cast at regular annual meetings of the membership of the Association in the manner set out in the Bylaws. Each director's term shall be for two (2) years, except as provided in the Bylaws as necessary to achieve staggered terms. In the event of a vacancy due to any reason other than recall or removal prior to the expiration of the Director's term, the remaining Directors may appoint a replacement to serve the balance of the director's unexpired term.

#### <u>ARTICLE V- REGISTERED OFFICE</u>

The street address of the registered office of the Association in the State of Florida shall be: 800 Village Square Crossing, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33410. The name of the registered agent at this address is Maria S. Leavy, whose address is 800 Village Square Crossing, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33410. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the registered office to any other address in Florida.

#### ARTICLE VI- ORIGINAL INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the original incorporator is: Arthur W. Trufelli, 5253 Center Street, Jupiter, FL 33458.

#### **ARTICLE VII- OFFICERS**

All Officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors from those directors serving on the Board in accordance with the Bylaws. The Board of Directors shall elect a President, Vice

President, Secretary, Treasurer, and such other Officers as it shall deem desirable, consistent with the Bylaws.

The current officer(s) and/or director(s) of the corporation is/are and who shall hold office and serve until removed or until their successors are elected at the next annual meeting of the members:

#### **ARTICLE VIII- MEMBERS**

Every person or entity who is a record owner of a fee or undivided fee interest in any lot shall be a member of the Association. Each lot shall be entitled to one (1) vote, with the voting rights as set forth in the Declaration and in the Bylaws.

#### **ARTICLE IX- CORPORATE EXISTANCE**

The Association shall have perpetual existence, unless the Association is terminated pursuant to the terms of these Articles. Upon dissolution of the Association, all of its assets remaining after provision for creditors and payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed among the members, pro rata.

#### ARTICLE X- AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be altered, amended, or rescinded only in the manner outlined herein. A majority of the Board of Directors or a majority of the voting members may propose alterations, amendments to, or the rescission of these Articles, so long as the proposals do not conflict with the Declaration. Such proposals shall set forth the proposed alteration, amendment, or rescission, shall be in writing, and shall be filed by the Board of Directors or a majority of the members. An affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Directors, and an affirmative vote of a majority of the voting members of the Association in good standing and eligible to vote who are present in person or by proxy at a meeting of the membership in which a quorum is present or by the written consent of a majority of the total voting members of the


Association in good standing and who are eligible to vote shall be required for the adoption of the proposed alteration, amendment or rescission.

## ARTICLE XI- INDEMNIFICATION OF DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, AND COMMITTEE MEMBERS

To the fullest extend authorized under applicable law, the Association shall indemnify and hold harmless each individual who shall serve at any time hereunder as a director, officer, or committee member of the Association from and against any and all claims, investigations, and liabilities to which such individual shall become subject by reason of his or her having been, or currently being a director, officer, or committee member and shall reimburse such individual for all legal and other expenses reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with such claim or liability. These provisions shall apply in all such instances except to the extent determined by a judgment or other final adjudication to have resulted from an individual's gross negligence, willful misconduct or fraudulent behavior, and provided that in the event of a settlement, the indemnification herein shall apply only when the Board of Directors approves such settlement. The Association shall maintain liability insurance for directors, officers, and committee members, if available.
