

Articles of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation of Mantanzas Foundation, Inc. N04000010986

Amendments adopted:

The articles listed below replace the correspondingly numbered articles in the original Articles of Incorporation.

Article 2. <u>Tax-Exempt Status</u>. The tax exempt purposes of this corporation shall be to receive and maintain a fund or funds of real or personal property or both and, subject to the restrictions and limitations which are hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the who or any part of the incomes from the principal of the fund or funds exclusively for charitable, religious, scientific, literary or educational purposes, either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under §501(c)(3) or §501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist of may hereafter be amended. Notwithstanding any other provision of those Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by organizations described in §501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

Article 4. Specific Purpose. The specific purpose of the non-profit corporation is:

The Corporation is named after the Cuban city of Matanzas, which was founded on Tuesday, October 13, 1693. The purpose of this organization is to unite the sons and daughters of the region as well as their descendants and the friend of Matanzas under the umbrella of this foundation. The Matanzas Foundation will, among other like-minded activities, engage in the following:

- a. Undertake a census of the sons and daughters of Matanzas and their descendants who either reside in Cuba or in exile.
- b. Conduct research and formulate recommendation to assist in the economic and social recovery of the region once the Castro regime has been removed from power.
- c. Organize activities to revive old bonds and create new ones among the foundation's members through social activities, publishing, cultural engagements, scholarships, and other activities permitted by law to further the purposes of this foundation.

The Corporation is organized to provide special services to the general community, and to the Cuban-American community, as permitted by the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

The Corporation is organized as a social club within the meaning of §501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Service Code.

Article 14. <u>Operational Limitations</u>. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under §501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 15. <u>Dissolution Clause</u>. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Governance Committee shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such a manner, to such organization or organizations organized and operated in such manner as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under §501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code, as the Governance Committee shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by order of a Court of competent jurisdiction of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
