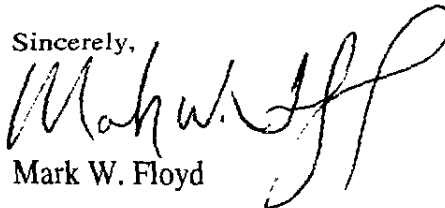

In compliance with the requirements of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the undersigned hereby act as incorporators in adopting and filing the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing a corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: THE JOSEPH H. KAPLAN CORPORATION FOR THE STUDY OF LABOR UNION HISTORY.

ARTICLE II

The street address of the principal office of the corporation is: 3900 Woodlake Boulevard, Suite 212, Lake Worth, Florida, 33463-3045.

ARTICLE III

The object and purpose of the corporation are charitable, educational, fraternal, civic and social; and other activities necessary or expedient in carrying out the purpose and object of the corporation; to hold or give entertainments, solicit charitable contributions for distribution to nationally-recognized and locally-recognized bona fide charitable organizations and, in general, to do any and all things necessary to carry out and further the charitable and educational purposes and object of the corporation.
