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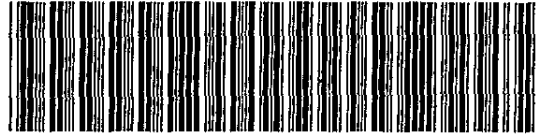

Articles of Incorporation
of

A Nonprofit Corporation

Pursuant to the provision of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (F.S.), the undersigned hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1

The name of this corporation is: Sunshine State Educational Clubs, Inc.

Article 2

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

58 Jamaica Street
Homosassa, Florida 34446-4275

Article 3

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are: to provide students from diverse social, economic, religious as well as race/ethnicity backgrounds with high quality supplemental educational services and programs that meet the needs of all students regardless of gender, physical or cognitive capabilities or restrictions.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c) (3) of The Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article 4

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed:

The Initial board of directors shall be appointed and serve until the first board meeting is held.

The board of directors will be re-elected at this meeting.

Article 5

The number of initial directors of this corporation shall be three and the names and addresses of the initial directors are as follows:

Article 9

The effective date for these articles of incorporation shall be January 31, 2005.

Article 10

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

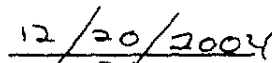
Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The undersigned hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the statements made in the foregoing Articles of Incorporation are true.
