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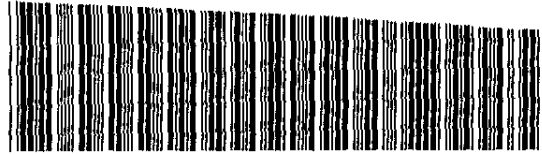

Article III:

The Purpose of the Foundation is to establish "Schools", aiming to provide clinical education experience as Nurse Assistants, Patient Care Technicians, Rehab Aids, Medical Assistants, Practical Nurse, Register Nurse in institutions hereinafter referred to as "The International Institute for business Technical & Medical Careers)" promoting high level of education among members of the minority community and/or to the low and moderated income members to the community at large. The Foundation will aim to remedy the lack of education to underprivileged children, single mothers, and poor parents proceeding from the third world especially from Haiti and other Caribbean Island

Purpose of the Foundation must have and exercise all the powers necessary or convenient to effect the objects for which it is formed, and in general to have and exercise all powers conferred by the State of Florida Division of Corporation described in section 501© of the Internal Revenue Code, Chapter 496, FS, upon corporations created. Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code and its regulation as they may now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

The foregoing enumeration of the objectives, purposes and powers of the organization is not intended to, and does not prohibit or limit the exercise of any other further rights or powers which may not or hereafter be allowed or permitted by law to the organization, provided, however, that all gifts and bequests to the organization, and the net earnings and assets of the corporation shall be used in the United States of America and/or any other country for the charitable and educational purposes for which it was formed.

The Foundation will not discriminate on the basis of race, religion or natural or ethnic origin during the admission of students. The school shall be open to any student covered in an interdictory agreement or residing in the State of Florida. The school will provide:

- 1) Education, training, Higher Education and support to individuals, organizations and members any groups or subgroups of the State of Florida minority community help them form, create and implement programs aiming to help the individuals and organizations.
- 2) Charitable, education or philanthropic activities with the purpose to improve the standard of living for members of the Haitians, communities as well any other minority groups, residents of the States of Florida.
- 3) Provide Post Secondary Education to people from low and moderated income
- 4) Provide tutorial and elemental education for those in need to prepare or raise their school GPA in order to be admitted in college.
- 5) Request charitable and philanthropic contributions monetary or otherwise with the purpose to finance the education of needed students.

Article IV. Manners of Election: Rose Foundation and Associates seeks for high profile professionals expert in the field of Medical and Nursing Education with high academic and religious values, willing to accept the responsibility of implementing policies for a college as well as to provide a positive and highly disciplined learning environment which promote the growth and development of the whole person. These professionals are brought to an out hock committee who will select the candidates after reviewing their credentials present the elected candidates to be "voted in by the School Board of Directors. Votes at the Board level are done viva voice.
