ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

ALACHUA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INCORPORATED, a Florida not-for-profit corporation

ursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida not-for-profit corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

FIRST: Article III, <u>Purpose</u>, paragraph 4, is hereby amended, and a new paragraph 5 is hereby added, to read as follows:

- 4. To generally support and promote the common economic interests of all commercial enterprises in the community of Alachua, Florida, in order to advance the general welfare and prosperity of Alachua, Florida so that its citizens and all areas of its business community shall prosper.
- 5. To observe all local, state and federal laws which apply to non-profit corporations as defined in Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code as amended from time to time and to undertake all activities necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the goals of the corporation, provided same are not in violation thereof. The corporation may engage in all activities permitted by state or federal law limited only by such activities that would effect its non-profit status.

Second: This amendment was adopted by the members on June 2009, and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.
