ARTICLES OF AMEDMENT TO

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF OLD NORTH BAY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

DOCUMENT # N05000000933

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 6171006, Florida Statutes, this *Florida Not For Profit* Corporation adopts the following amendments to its articles of incorporation:

[Article IX]: Amendment adopted: The Not For Profit Corporation shall have the power to operate and maintain the surface water management system facilities, including all inlets, ditches, swales, culverts, water control structures, retention and detention areas, ponds, lakes, floodplain compensation areas, wetlands and any associated buffer areas, and wetland mitigation areas.

[Article XI]: Amendment adopted: The Not For Profit Corporation shall exist in perpetuity; however, the articles of incorporation shall provide that if the association is dissolved, the control or right of access to the property containing the surface water management system facilities shah be conveyed or dedicated to an appropriate governmental unit or public utility and that if not accepted, then the surface water management system facilities shall be conveyed to a non-profit corporation similar to the association.
