AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION IN THE PLACE OF GOD MINISTRIES, INC

(Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation)

The undersigned persons, acting as incorporators of a corporation not for profit under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act, as set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statues, adopt the following Amended Articles of Incorporation for such corporation;

ARTICLE 1 NAME & ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is IN THE PLACE OF GOD MINISTRIES, INC. The physical address of the corporation is 15915 US Highway 301; Dade City Florida 33523. The mailing address of the corporation is P.O. Box 1514, Dade City, Florida 33526.

ARTICLE 2 PURPOSE

The specific purpose for which the corporation is initially organized is to establish and oversee places of worship, conduct the work of evangelism worldwide, create departments necessary to support missionary activities and to license and oversee ministers of the gospel and to also engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose, or which are incidental thereto or connected therewith which are consistent with Section 501©3 of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501©3Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation will not perform any other activities not permitted by, (i) a corporation exempt from federal income tax, under Section 501©3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or (ii) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170©2 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501©3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE 3 QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS AND MANNER OF ADMISSION

This corporation is organized upon a non-stock basis as defined in Section 617.011 of the Florida Statutes. The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the board of directors. The authorized number and qualifications of the members of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different classes of membership, if any the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collections thereof, shall be as regulated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE 4 TERM

The date of commencement of corporate existence shall be when these articles have been filed with the Department of State and approved by it and the respective filing fee has been paid; the term for which the corporation is to exist shall be perpetual. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code. In the event of dissolution of the corporation, no part of the corporation's earnings or assets shall inure to the benefit of any of its members; the residual assets of the corporation shall be distributed to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986, or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to the federal, state or local government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE 5 NON PROFIT ORGANIZATION

No part of the net earning of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article 2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or: (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue laws.

ARTICLE 6 INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name of the Initial Registered Agent of the corporation is COWARD & COWARD, PA, and the street address of the Initial Registered Agent of this corporation is 7101 W COMMERICIAL BLVD; SUITE 4A, FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA 33319.

ARTICLE 7 INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE 8 DIRECTORS

The board of directors of the corporation shall consist of no less than three (3) directors as determined by the bylaws. Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the members in the manner set forth in the bylaws. Directors may be removed and the vacancies shall be filled in the manner provided by the bylaws. The directors named in these articles shall serve as directors for the ensuing year, or until the first annual meeting of the corporation, and any vacancies before then shall be filled in the manner set forth in the bylaws. The board of directors shall have the authority to make provision for reasonable compensation to its members for their services as directors and to fix the basis and conditions upon which this compensation shall be paid. Any director may also serve the corporation in any other capacity and receive compensation there from in any form. The directors whose positions and duties are set forth in the bylaws will manage the affairs of this corporation.
