

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporation(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

New Emmaus Missionary Baptist Church Full Gospel Ministry, Inc.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPLE OFFICE

The principle place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

5729 Vernon Road Jacksonville, Florida 32209

ARTICLE III

SECTION 2.1 PURPOSE, LIMITATION AND DISSOLUTION

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: New Emmaus Missionary Baptist Church - New Testament Local Church, professing believers in Christ, who have been baptized by the spirit of Christ into his body and organized to carry out the great commission, go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and Holy Ghost: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen. (Matthew 28:19-20), and to carry out God's will here on earth as the pillar and the ground of the truth (I Timothy 3:15). A community of believers, and they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and

breaking bread from house to house did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. (Acts 2:46-47); this includes a number of things: observing the ordinances, evangelizing, building up believers, worship services, paying tithes and giving offerings, ministering to all age groups, and to all people etc. The Emmaus Church has five (5) branches to operate through the five (5) basic structures which are:

BRANCHES OF OUR LABOR FOR CHRIST AND ALL OF OUR MINISTRIES WILL RUN WELL, ABOVE REPROACH, INDUSTRIOUSLY HONEST IN THE SIGHT OF GOD AND MEN

*Pastoral Office and Ministry

Everything heads up in the pastoral office, the ultimate responsibility for all the church, the care of all the people and the smooth running of all the interrelated parts, the services of public worship and everything that pertains to the church is in the charge and keeping of the pastor and his pastoral staff.

* The Educational Ministry encompasses all the teaching ministries of the church Sunday School, church training, Vacation Bible School, and a multitude of other like ministries.

*The Music Ministry enlists the talents of the whole congregation to praise the Lord in melody, in lyric, in special programs, ect.

*The Mission - Outreach Ministry is our ministry to our Jerusalem, the City of Jacksonville, (Acts 1:8) says, but ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you; and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. We will develop and implement faith based initiatives that transforms and foster the quality of life for everyone, and target the social ills of our community, and help to reduce the poverty rates, and the violent rates. We will partner with governmental programs and other faith-based organizations to offer successful programs and social services to diverse socio-economics, and disadvantaged persons including the disabled.

*The business office ministry is responsible for the entire physical plant the financial procedures, the reports to the deacons and the church concerning our church records, and all the other matters that pertain to the church as a terrestrial organization with its feet planted on the earth. The custodians, the dining facilities and food services, the monthly and annual report of the work of the congregation, the payment of loans and mortgages, the personal records of the tithing and giving of our members are dependent upon that office.

The New Emmaus Missionary Baptist Church will hold business meetings with the whole church body twice a year at scheduled times agreed by the pastor and congregation.

The New Emmaus Missionary Baptist Church shall be authorized and empowered to pay their pastor and ministerial staff reasonable compensation for services rendered according to the Word of God; Scriptural support (I Timothy 5:17-18; 2 Corinthians 9:10-15; Luke 10:7).

Section 2.2 Limitations on Actions no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to any member, director, officer or other private person, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in section 2.1 of this Article. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Section 2.3 <u>Dissolution</u>; upon the dissolution of the corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively to such charitable; religious, scientific or educational organizations which would then exist and qualify as an exempt organization under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or if not, to such organization or organizations which are then so qualified as the Board of Directors shall

determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or to such organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes as the court shall determine.

ARTICLE IV

PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law. This corporation existence shall commence with filing with the Secretary of State.

<u>ARTICLE V</u>

This corporation is original under a non-stock basis.

ARTICLE VI

MANNER OF ELECTION

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed: the qualification of directors and the manner of their admission and dismissal shall be developed by the Board of Directors, and provided for in the by-laws, which shall govern the internal affairs of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII

INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The number constituting the initial Board of Directors, trustees or managers of the corporation is five. The initial Board of Directors will serve until the scheduled business meeting. When the whole New Emmaus Missionary Baptist Church body meet and accept the recommendations from the initial Board of Directors to elect if needed Directors in compliance with the Bylaws.
