ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with the requirements of the Laws of the State of Florida, and for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, the undersigned does hereby acknowledge:

Article I- Name

Name of the Corporation. The name of the corporation shall be: Florida Citizens Police Academy Association, Inc.

Article II- Principal Office

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be: Florida Citizens Police Academy Association, Inc.

c/o Pasco Sheriff's Office 8700 Citizen Drive

New Port Richey, Florida 34654

Article III- Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: To provide education and support to Citizen Police Academy and Volunteer Programs throughout the State of Florida through information sharing, training, and networking.

This organization is organized exclusively for charitable, and or educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of these purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on:

(a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code or

(b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for 501 (c)(3) purposes.

Article IV- Membership

The Directors, and the Officers of the Corporation who are also Directors, are elected by the members of the Association at the annual meeting. The Directors other than Officers are elected for three years, the Officers are elected for two years; each person may be reelected with no limitation in the number of terms they may serve. The details for the election system is established in the Corporation's By-Laws.
