ATTACHEMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE COUNTY BUZZ, INC.

Article III Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes. The terms charitable, scientific and educational shall have the same meanings herein that they have in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provisions of any future federal internal revenue laws then in effect.

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the purpose of this corporation shall include the following:

- 1. <u>Education.</u> The County Buzz will educate school age students on how to prepare for and pass ACT, FCAT and SAT exams as well as publish useful information on college admission process, available scholarships and provide tips on how to obtain these scholarships.
- 2. Development of interest in of school age students in sports and athletics. The County Buzz will publish information on scholarships available to middle and high school athletes, feature current and future sports competitions in its community, spotlight stories about local high school graduates who achieved a certain level of success in sports, as well as hallmark athletes who deserve recognition for their achievements in school and sports. In addition to its monthly publication, The County Buzz will organize sports camps to identify unrecognized talent and to encourage students to participate in education and sports.
- 3. <u>Health and fitness education</u>. The County Buzz will publish information about health, obesity in kids and the importance of exercise for teenagers. It will publish articles about the benefits of maintaining a healthy lifestyle and diet, and will recommend various exercise and stretching programs for strengthening body and mind.
- 4. <u>Community awareness and outreach.</u> The County Buzz will provide useful information about education and sports events for school age students in the community and feature various businesses and programs that help school age students succeed in school, sports and life.

To achieve these purposes The County Buzz will attract charitable donations from individuals and business entities as well as qualify for federal and state grant programs for the public benefit of educating high school students; provided, however, that notwithstanding the foregoing enumeration of particular purposes found in this paragraph, this corporation shall not engage in any activity which may not be engaged in

by a corporation which is exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provisions of any future federal internal revenues laws then in effect.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation. This corporation shall not directly or indirectly participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distributing of statements) in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings or other assets of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any director, officer, contributor, or other private individual, having, directly or indirectly, any personal or private interest in the activities of this corporation, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of selection 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.
