TWO: This corporation is a nonprofit religious benefit corporation and is organized to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ The corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for Religious purposes. To establish structured support services Evangelistic, Economic Development and Other Ministries to support the outreach ministries for the body of Jesus Christ the Church). In accordance with the Doctrine of the Corporation creed / by-laws as a pastor to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ The religious program will consist of Economic Development programs, but shall not be limited to: Homelessness Health Care, Child Care, Youth At High Risk, Tutorial Land Acquisition, Housing, Job Training. Counseling Employment, Christian Education and other programs to aid those in need.

The purpose of the corporation shall be: to cultivate, promote, promulgate and extend, educational and charitable works, such as drug rehabilitation counseling and facilities, feeding program for the elderly, and women in distress counseling; to teach and help people of all race, creed and color by ways of media; to adopt, and establish By-laws, and management of its affairs, in accordance with the law and not inconsistent with these Articles of incorporation; take, manage and dispose of property, real and personal, buy and sell of the Corporation. To borrow money contract debt, and lease bonds notes and debentures, and secure payments or performance of its obligations. To do all acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purpose of the corporation, including e.g., the establishment of schools, seminars, youth center, etc. oriented to organizational principles. Being able to service, setup, operate in foreign and domestic, national and international, {global} boundaries.

To raise the economic, educational and social levels of the underprivileged residents of Broward County, Florida, and other similar communities, who are substantially underemployed and have income, who are proportionately more after victims of crime, by fostering and promoting community wide interest and concern for problems of such residents, and to that end; (a) Racial tension, prejudice, discrimination, economic and otherwise, be eliminated; (b) Sickness, poverty and crime may be lessened; and (c) Educational and economic opportunities may be expanded among the residents of Broward and Dade County, Florida and other surrounding areas
