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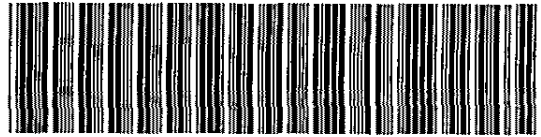

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HOBBS MIDDLE SCHOOL CHORUS BOOSTERS, INC.

A Not-for-Profit Corporation

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is **HOBBS MIDDLE SCHOOL CHORUS BOOSTERS, INC.**

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

(1) **HOBBS MIDDLE SCHOOL CHORUS BOOSTERS, INC.**, is organized to support the Hobbs Middle School chorus in Milton, Florida, and all other lawful business.

Anything in these articles of incorporation to the contrary notwithstanding, the purpose or purposes for which this corporation is organized are limited to those that will qualify it as an example organization under Internal Revenue code Section **501(c)(3)**, including, for those purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as tax-exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code.

This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation. This corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for

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public office.

No part of the net earnings, properties or assets of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of any private person or individual or any member or director of this corporation. On liquidation or dissolution all properties and assets of this corporation remaining after paying or providing for all debts and obligations shall be distributed and paid over to a fund, foundation or corporation organized and operated for charitable or religious purposes designated by the board of directors which shall at the time qualifies as a tax-exempt organization under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3), or as that statute may be amended.

ARTICLE IV - DIRECTORS

There shall be four members of the initial Board of Directors of the corporation. The method of electing Directors shall be as stated in the Constitution and By-Laws of the corporation. There shall be no fewer than two members of the Board of Directors. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial Directors are as follows:

ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the Corporation shall be governed by the Constitution and By-Laws and the Corporation is formed on a non-stock basis.

ARTICLE VI - REGISTERED OFFICE

The initial principal office and mailing address of the corporation shall be located at 5317 Glover Lane, Milton, Florida 32570. The initial registered agent of the corporation shall be Brenda L. Kahler, whose address is 5566 Booker Street, Milton, Florida 32570.

ARTICLE VIII - OFFICERS

Section 1. The officers and agents of the corporation shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and any such other officers or agents as may be provided by the By-Laws or appointed and authorized by the Directors.

Section 2. The officers shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors or as provided in the By-Laws.


ARTICLE IX - BY-LAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal By-Laws shall be by majority vote of the Board of Directors or by majority vote of the Members.

ARTICLE X - AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment to them, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
