ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF EDEN CREATIVE ARTS UNIVERSITY, INC. (A NOT-FOR-PROFIT)

Pursuant to Section 617.0202 Florida Statutes, the undersigned subscriber (s) is desirous of forming a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, and hereby petition the Secretary of State for approval of such incorporation under the following proposed Certificate on Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Corporation is EDEN CREATIVE ARTS UNIVERSITY, INC., a Not-for-Profit organization.

ARTICLE II

PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is 5335 NW CT. Suite number 110 Plantation, Florida 33313 as deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors/Trustees.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The organization is organized exclusively for the purpose of promoting responsible education, knowledge awareness, and compassion among members, students and associates. EDEN CREATIVE ARTS UNIVERSITY, INC., wishes to communicate

and provide advanced knowledge and leadership to its students without regard to gender, sexual preference, origin, nationality, race, political affiliation and religious beliefs.
