Articles of Incorporation

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, propose to become an educational corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for a non-profit educational association, under a charter as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be _____
SMART KIDS LEARNING CENTER, INC and it is to be located in the State of Florida, County of Broward.

ARTICLE II

The general purpose and plan of operation of this corporation shall be to establish and operate an educational center in Broward County, Florida, to buy, to manage, to own and to hold real and personal property necessary and proper for a school to carry on educational and charitable work. To contribute to the educational growth of this community.

ARTICLE III

The terms of admission and qualification for membership in this corporation shall be by application, written or oral and approved by appointment by the Chief Executive Officer. ARTICLE XI


