ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE INDONESIAN STUDENTS AND ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF FLORIDA, INC.

(A Florida corporation not-for-profit)

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation not-for-profit under the laws of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is: The Indonesian Students and Alumni Association of Florida, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The location of its principal place of business in this State shall be

203 NE 212 Terrace, Miami, FL 33179

ARTICLE III. PURPOSES

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, social, cultural, fraternal, networking, and professional development purposes including, for such purposes, the making of contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, including, but not limited to the following purposes:

- a. To help victims of natural disaster in the Republic of Indonesia by distributing funds to the affected areas to help rebuilding their lives and assisting their children to gain their education back.
- b. To do all things necessary and appropriate for carrying out and exercising the foregoing purposes and powers.
- c. To establish contact and cooperation with similar non-profit organizations to strengthen the corporation in carrying out the mission and purposes.
- d. To receive and maintain a fund or funds, and subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole of any part of the income there from and the principal thereof exclusively for charitable, educational, social, cultural, fraternal, networking, and professional development purposes either directly or by contributing to organizations that

qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

- e. To promote, strengthen and develop the bonds of friendship, brotherhood and sisterhood that should exist among members of the Indonesian Students and Alumni.
- f. To study, discuss and define its interests when and wherever they may be necessary and to promote and encourage the professional advancements of members of the Indonesian Students and Alumni.
- g. To promote and participate in events celebrating or commemorating national holidays and other significant dates or occasions recognized in the Republic of Indonesia.
- h. To promote Indonesian culture and society trough cultural or traditional exhibitions, food festivals, bazaars, seminars, and others.
- i. To inform job opportunities through networking for Indonesian Students graduating from universities, colleges, and vocational schools.
- j. To organize sports, physical fitness, and wellness programs for members of the Indonesian Students and Alumni.
- k. To provide members of Indonesian Student and Alumni with information concerning occasions, or events that are likely to be of interests, including but not limited to births, graduations, weddings, career advancements, accidents, sickness, and deaths of or affecting other members.
- In the event of dissolutions of this corporation, or in the event it shall cease to carry out the objects and purposes herein set forth, all business, property and assets of the corporation shall go and be distributed to one or more such nonprofit organizations as may be selected by the board of directors of this corporation, to be used for, and devoted to, the purpose of carrying on the charitable project for promoting the general social welfare of the Indonesian community. In no event shall any of the assets or property, in the event of disbursement of any sum subscribed, donated, or contributed by such members, or for any other purpose provided that nothing herein shall prohibit the corporation from paying its just debts.

ARTICLE IV. MANNER OF ELECTION

The management of the affairs of the incorporation shall be under the control, supervision and direction of the board of directors. The classifications, qualifications, duties, terms

and other matters relating to the board of directors shall be provided in the by-laws. The Directors shall also serve as officers of the corporation and the qualifications, manner of selection, duties, terms and other matters relating to the officers of the corporation shall be provided in the by-laws.
