CHARTER OF  
FORT PIERCE Hellenic Association, Inc.

TO: THE HONORABLE A. O. KANIER, one of the Judges of the Circuit Court of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida, in and for St. Lucie County,

We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida, applicable to corporations not for profit, under the following Charter:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be "FORT PIERCE Hellenic Association, Inc." and it is to be located in Fort Pierce, St. Lucie County, Florida.

ARTICLE II

The nature and objects of this corporation are:

1. To strive for human and spiritual rather than to the material values of life.
2. To encourage the golden rule in all human relationships.
3. To develop by precept and example an intelligent aggressive and serviceable citizenship, thus making it possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism and good will.
4. To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

ARTICLE III

The membership of the Corporation shall consist of persons of good character and community standing, who shall have such qualifications as may be prescribed by the By-Laws of this corporation, from time to time.

ADMISSION TO MEMBERSHIP AND RESIGNATION

All persons who have signed this Charter and whose names and addresses appear below shall become members of this Corporation upon the approval of this Charter by the Circuit Court, and to be known as Charter members.

Subsequent thereto all members shall be admitted to membership under such procedure as may be prescribed by the By-Laws of this Corporation.

Any member may resign his membership in the Corporation, provided that all his indebtedness to the Corporation has been paid. The resignations shall be submitted in writing to the Board of Directors and shall become effective when accepted by the Board.

#### ARTICLE IV

Any member of the Corporation who shall be charged with conduct unbecoming to a member of this Corporation, as such conduct may be defined under the By-laws of this Corporation or under the customs and usages of members of this Corporation, generally, and such charges are sustained, after due and proper hearing before the Board of Directors, may be expelled from membership in the Corporation by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the entire Board of Directors.

Any member may be dropped from membership in the Corporation for reasons other than disciplinary reasons only as provided in and according to the procedure prescribed in the By-Laws of this Corporation.

No Incorporator nor member of this Corporation shall have any vested right, interest, or privilege of, in or to the assets, functions, affairs, franchises of the Corporation, or any right, interest, or privilege which may be transferable or inheritable, or which shall continue after his membership ceases or while he is a member not in good standing; provided, that before his membership shall cease against his or her consent he or she shall be given an opportunity to be heard, unless he or she is absent from the County of St. Lucie, State of Florida, under conditions from which the Board of Directors may conclude that he or she has left the County for an extended period of time or permanently.

#### ARTICLE V

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.
