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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE L NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Pinecrest Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation is: 12645 South Dixie Highway, Pinecrest, Florida 33156.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE(S)

The specific purpose(s) for which the corporation is organized is to provide financial and other support to the Village of Pinecrest, Florida, in order for said Village of Pinecrest to carry out community programs in the areas of parks and recreation, library, education and culture.

ARTICLE IV. MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE V. ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND BYLAWS

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended only by the Pinecrest Village Council. The Bylaws and any amendments thereto must be approved by the Pinecrest Village Council.

ARTICLE VI. CONTROL

The corporation shall adhere to and be bound by any and all ordinances enacted by the Pinecrest Village Council applicable to the corporation or its activities.

ARTICLE VIL MEMBER

The sole member of the corporation shall be the Pinecrest Village Council (the "Member"). The rights of the Member shall be as set forth in the Bylaws and the Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE X. CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS PROVISIONS

Notwithstanding any powers granted to the Corporation by its Articles, Bylaws or by the laws of the State of Florida, the following limitations of power shall apply:

- a. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code").
- b. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for the services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under Code Section 501(c)(3); or (ii) by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Code Section 170(c)(2).
- c. Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Code Section 501(c)(3), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the court having jurisdiction over the Corporation, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE XI. NONDISCRIMINATION

No person shall be denied association with, participation in the programs of, or other involvement with the activities of the Corporation on the basis of race, creed, national origin, age, expland(cap, or religion.
