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# ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT FOR DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS FLORIDA SUNCOAST JUNIOR GOLF TOUR, ING. JUN -8 PM 3:33

The undersigned President and Secretary of the above referenced corporation hereby files these Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

The Articles of Incorporation are hereby amended by changing the following Article:

### ARTICLE III

- A. The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The following is added to the Articles of Incorporation:

## ARTICLE VIII

A. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall

be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of nay future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state, or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

This Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the Directors on June 1, 2006. No member approval is required.
