NOT FOR PROFIT ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SUNLIGHT CHRISTIAN ACADEMY, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, desiring to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, does hereby accept all of the rights and privileges, benefits and obligations conferred and imposed by said laws and does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation as the Charter of the Corporation hereby organized.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be SUNLIGHT CHRISTIAN ACADEMY, INC.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State, State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES AND POWERS

DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS
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Section 1. This Corporation is organized for the purpose of ownership and operation of a Christian pre-school and school, engaging in the education of children as part of a corporation organized under the Florida General Corporation Law, as in effect from time to time. Furthermore, the purposes are to worship and glorify God, to teach, train, lead, and encourage God's children and our members in their spiritual life and growth, and to reach out with the gospel message of Jesus Christ to all people in the greater Port St. Lucie area to become members of this corporation, this Academy, and the church universal.

Section 2. The Corporation shall have all the powers set forth in the Florida General Corporation law, as in effect from time to time, and including but not limited to the following powers:

(a) To construct, erect, repair and remodel buildings and structures of all types for itself and others and to manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire; and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, property and services of every class, kind and description; except that it is not to conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, surety, express, railroad, canal, telephone, telegraph or cemetery company, a building and loan association, mutual fire insurance association, cooperative association, fraternal benefit society, state fair or exposition.

(b) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire real and personal property and leaseholds thereof and interest therein, and to own, hold, manage, develop, improve, equip, maintain and operate, and to sell, convey, exchange, lease or otherwise alienate and dispose of, and to mortgage, pledge or otherwise encumber any and all such property and any an all legal and equitable rights thereunder and interest therein.

(c) To borrow or raise money for any of the purposes of the Corporation and from time to time without limit as to amount to draw, make, accept, endorse, execute and issue promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrants, bonds, debentures and other negotiable and nonnegotiable instruments and evidences of indebtedness; and to secure payment thereof and any interest therein by mortgage, pledge, creation of a security interest, conveyance or other assignment in trust, in whole or in part, of the assets of the Corporation, real, personal or mixed, including contract rights, whether at the time owned or thereafter acquired.

(d) To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of or any bonds, security, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and

while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

(e) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts and arrangements of every sort and kind which may be necessary or convenient for the business of the Corporation or business of a similar nature with any person, firm, corporation, association or syndicate or any private, public or municipal body existing under the government of the United States or any state, territory, colony or dependency thereof or foreign government so far as or to the extent that the same may be done or performed pursuant to law.

(f) To enter into or become a partner in any agreement for sharing a union of interest, cooperation, joint venture or otherwise with any person, firm or corporation now carrying on or about to carry on any business which this Corporation has the direct or incidental authority to pursue.

(g) To do everything necessary, proper, advisable or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes of the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, and to do every other act and thing incidental thereto or connected therewith, to the extend permitted by law.

ARTICLE IV

ADMINISTRATION

The administration of this Corporation and selection of its directors shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, and in accordance with the Church Order of the Christian Reformed Church in North America as adopted and revised by the Synod.

ARTICLE V

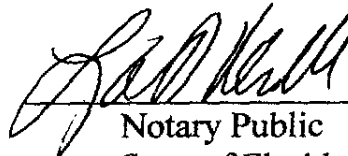
