For the past two years my wife and I, along with other members of the Life Center Church, have been ministering at various locations in Orlando, and surrounding areas, attached is an outline of these locations and time. Not only have we been able to preach/teach the Word of God at these locations but we have also provided complete breakfast at the Coalition for the Homeless on every 1st and 3rd Saturdays. Additionally 3 times this year we provided clothing, blankets and hygiene packages for these men. We also set up and showed the film "The Passion of the Christ". We set up and play Christian music at each of these feeding. We also provide personal Bibles for each of these persons. We have also provided bicycles for some of the men for transportation, to and from work. On some occasions we have picked these men up from the shelter, took them to church and took them home to eat and fellowship. Every other month we minister at Guardian Care Nursing Home, where we preach/teach the Word of God and play Christian music. We have donated a CD Player and a number of CD's at this facility.

Once monthly we minister at the work release center at Polk Correctional. Along with ministering the word through preaching and teaching we also provided a CD Player and a number of CD's for these men. Each of these men has been given Bibles and on one occasion Bibles were sent to family member of their choosing in their name as Christmas presents.

At the Orlando Rescue Mission we minister, preach/teach the Word of God each 1st, 4th and 5th Sunday nights during our tenyor there we have been able to donate a CD Player along with CD's. On one occasion we provided portable CD Player and CD's for each of the teenaged children as Christmas presents.

We have also distributed personal Bibles to every resident and their children. Once per quarter we provide CD's and Bibles for each of the new residents. We have provided field trips (i.e.) trips to the movies and trips to the skating rank. The young men and their father's have attended our supper bowl fellowship parties. Halloween Fest and other function sponsored by the Life Center Church. We have also provided bicycles for transportation at this facility.

Twice per year we take the Gospel to a nursing home in Live Oak, Florida. (Surrey's Place) We minister the Word of God play music, and provide CD's to be left with that facility. We have learned that many of the patients there really enjoy some of the old songs that they are familiar with.

At the Coalition for the Homeless at lease once per year we set up the bar-b-que grill and serve hot dogs, hamburgers, along with chips and drinks. During these feedings/gathering we bring in singers and musicians for the life center and other churches to sing and minister to these men on an all day excursion.

During the past year we have provided food baskets for 8 families in the Órlando area. We also co-sponsored a trip to Jamaica where we packed and shipped 7 barrels of food, clothing and Bibles to these men, women and children.

Our purpose and goal in doing all this is peradventure we can reach at lease one of the men, women, boys and girls who are not saved, or are in a backslidden state, and reunite them to the body of Christ. We attempt to let them know that no matter how dark and bleak their situation may be, God still loves them, and is ready to meet their every need if they would give their life to him and obey him. Those who are unsaved we introduce them to Jesus. We let them know that God loves them, and that Jesus is standing at the door of their heart, knocking, waiting, for them to open up and let him in that he may establish a relationship with them. We let them know that no matter how dark and bleak their situation may be God still loves them and is extending that love through us to bring them in the full knowledge of him, Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. Those who are saved we extend a word of encouragement and hope as they endure the hardships of life.

On December 21, 2005, we provided food, toys, bibles, and ministry to 48 young men at the Polk juvenile detention center through the Leland Family Ministries, Inc.

We are excited about what God is doing through us and look forward to doing even more to bring relief and the word of God to as many men, women, boys, and girls as we can.

These efforts have been financed by, private businesses, personal donations, and other churches in the community. We have formed a corporation, under the name Agape Profecting Ministries, Inc. and have filed for a 501 C-3 exemption, in order that those investing, or supporting this worthy cause may receive a tax write off for their contribution. The organizations, churches, individuals, or businesses making these contributions, are asked to accompany us at these locations and assist in serving and ministering to these people.
