ARTICLE I. NAME

INC.

The name of this corporation is AMERICAN ME'TIS ABORIGINAL ASSOCIATION CHURCH OF THE ME'TIS TRIBE INC.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of:

- 1. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, literacy, scientific and educator purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 5010 (3) of such Code.
- To provide spiritual leadership for Florida aboriginal people of mixed blood decent. Historically, the Metis being warm, caring and friendly people, we welcome friends and other native American cultures to worship with us. To educate and ordain clergy in ancient and modern Spiritual beliefs of whom with the use and possession of sacred objects required in

traditional Metis religious practices. To conduct ceremonies, dances, pow-wows, wedding, funeral and sweet lodges in accordances with Metis culture and with the U. S. Public law #96-341 Aug. 11, 1978 American Indian Religious Freedom 42 USC 1996

Jay Treaty- 1794 (1) between the U.S. and Canada.

- 2. No part of the earnings of the Corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensations for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.
- 3. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation, shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing and distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 4. Notwithstanding and other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal

Revenue Code, (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or [©] by a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

5. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
