ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF JUSTICE AND ADVOCACY CENTER FOR CHILDREN, INC.

A Not For Profit Corporation

PREABLE

The undersigned citizens of the United States, desiring to form a not for profit corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, certify and acknowledge the following:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Corporation Not for Profit shall be the JUSTICE AND ADVOCACY CENTER FOR CHILDREN, INC.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

PRINCIPLE OFFICE

The Principle office and mailing address of the Corporation shall be 723 Rosalie Way, Winter Springs, Florida, 32708.

ARTICLE IV

PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and education
purposes within the meaning of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as
may be amended, including for such purposes making of distributions to
organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) or
corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

- 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not engage in any other activities not permitted to be engaged a corporation exempt form Federal Income tax under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- The specific purpose of JUSTICE AND ADVOCACY CENTER FOR CHILDREN, Inc. is to protect and advocate the legal rights of poor or at-risk children.

ARTICLE V

ELECTION OF CORPORATE DIRECTORS

The directors of the Corporation shall be elected in accordance with methods and qualifications specified in the bylaws of the corporation. In no event, shall the number of directors be fewer than three.

ARTICLE VI

POWERS

The powers of the Corporation shall be provided in the bylaws of the Corporation in accordance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes with the following limitations within the meaning of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as may amended:

- No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, directors, officers or other private interests.
 However, the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay a reasonable flat salary for services rendered by its employees and to make payments and other distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV (1).
- 2. Only an insubstantial amount of the activities of the Corporation shall be in furtherance of a purpose not set forth in Article IV.
- 3. Only an insubstantial amount of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, within the meaning of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as may be

- amended, unless the Corporation elects the provisions of § 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code, as may amended.
- 4. In no event shall the Corporation have the power to participate in, or intervene in, including the publishing or distributing of statements, any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office, all within the meaning of § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as may be amended.
- 5. In the event the Corporation chooses to litigate, using its own staff attorneys on behalf of its members or other clients, the Corporation shall comply with the guidelines provided within Revenue Procedure 92-59, 19922 C.B. 411-12, as may be amended, superseded or modified. The bylaws of the Corporation shall adopt these provisions accordingly.

ARTICLE VII

MEETINGS

- After incorporation, the appropriate members of the Corporation shall hold an organizational meeting in accordance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as amended.
- 2. The board of directors of the Corporation may participate in a regular or special meeting by, or conduct the meeting through, the use of any means of communication which allows all directors participating to simultaneously hear one another. A director participating in such a meeting is deemed present at the meeting. In the alternative, the board of directors may take actions through signed e-mail communications provided all board members agree.

DISSOLUTION
