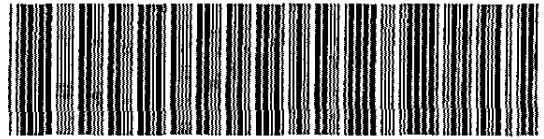

**ARTICLES OF CORPORATION
PHUOC VIEN BUDDHIST TEMPLE INC.**

ARTICLE I

Name

The Name of the Corporation is **"PHUOC VIEN BUDDHIST TEMPLE INC."**.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business and mailing address of
PHUOC VIEN BUDDHIST TEMPLE INC." is

Jacksonville, Florida 32208

ARTICLE III

The Corporation is organized pursuant to the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code.

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized are as follows:

- (a) To establish a Buddhist Temple in serving Buddhist believers in community and engaging in any other related religious activities, and for such purposes to have and to exercise all the powers now or hereinafter conferred by the Laws of the State of Florida.
- (b) To provide assistance and services to community members.
- (c) To promote cooperation among organizations in advancing purposes similar to the ones pursued by the Corporation.
- (d) This organization is organized exclusively for charitable and religious purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organization that qualify as exempt organization under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- (e) No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purposes clause thereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from

- federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section of any future federal tax code.
- (f) Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purposes. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IV

The manner in which the Directors are elected according to the By-Law. The Corporation shall consist of an Abbot and a government Board of Directors.

Section I: The Abbot shall be selected by government Board of Directors and by Monk Council, and shall execute the policies as established by that Board.

Section II: The government Board of Directors shall consist of 6 members, from whom the officers are to be chosen.
