Article III and Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation of Plantation Equestrian Foundation, Inc. are hereby deleted in their entirety and the following Article III and Article IV are hereby substituted therefore:

## ARTICLE III

## **PURPOSE**

The Corporation is organized to operate as a tax exempt organization within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (hereinafter the "Code"), and whose purpose is to promote, foster, support and educate the public concerning amateur equestrian sports including, but not limited to, the equestrian skills of riding, driving, jumping, showing and training and through sponsoring amateur competition in equestrian sports among the residents of the City of Plantation, Florida and others. The Corporation shall not engage in any activity which will jeopardize the tax-exempt status of the Corporation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

### ARTICLE IV

### **POWERS**

- 4.1 The Corporation shall possess and exercise all the powers and privileges granted by Chapters 607 and 617 of the Florida Statutes, or by any other law of Florida, together with all powers necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion or attainment of the activities or purposes of the Corporation, limited only by the restrictions set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.
- 4.2 The Corporation is organized not for profit and no part of the income of said Corporation shall ever be distributed to or inure to the benefit of any member of the Board of Directors, officer or any private individual.

- 4.2-1 No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the dissemination of propaganda, lobbying, or other attempts to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 4.2-2 Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not conduct or carry on activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on (i) by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and its Treasury Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be promulgated or amended; and (ii) by a not for profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida as they now exist or may be hereafter amended.
