# ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF CORRECTION

#### ARTICLE VII - DISSOLUTION OF ORGANIZATION

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed to Georgetown University, Washington, D.C., if such distribution is permitted under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or such assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
