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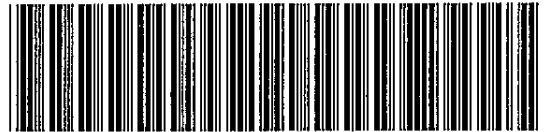

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Center for Cooperative Justice, Inc. The corporation shall be a not-for-profit corporation that is organized pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be the following:

ARTICLE III

The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the United States Code, as amended or later codified ("26 U.S.C."). The corporation shall not be operated for profit. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, officers, directors or other private persons or entities, except that the corporation may pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation outside the purview of the exceptions provided in 26 U.S.C. §501(h). The corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Upon the dissolution of corporation, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of its liabilities, the corporation shall dispose of all of its assets exclusively for the purposes of corporation, in such manner or to such organization

or organizations organized and operated exclusively for such purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under 26 U.S.C §501(c)(3). Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by an appropriate court of competent jurisdiction in which the principal office of the corporation is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as the court shall determine, that are organized and operated exclusively for those purposes.

Notwithstanding any other provisions, the corporation shall only carry on activities that are permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under 26 U.S.C. §501(c)(3) and (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under 26 U.S.C. §170(c)(2).

ARTICLE IV

The bylaws of the corporation shall set forth the method of election of the directors.

ARTICLE V

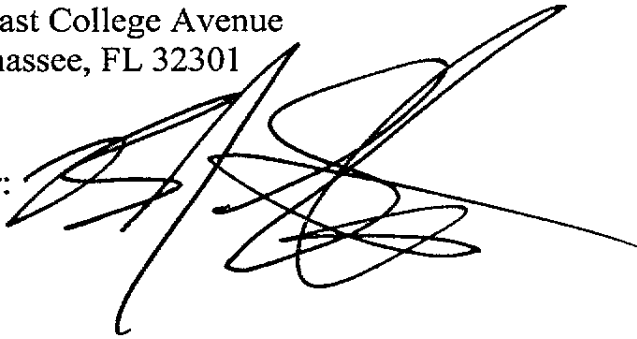
