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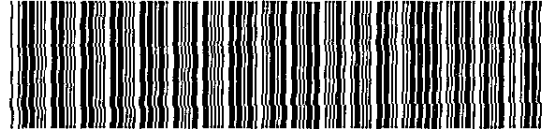

Article III Purpose

The North American Russian Communication Association, Inc. shall complement and assist the Russian Communication Association in its work to develop and popularize study of the theories and practices of human communication as a special academic field and discipline and to develop and expand the human communication component in the secondary and higher education curricula in Russia. The North American Russian Communication Association, Inc. will work to unify intellectual, professional, educational, material, and financial resources pursuant to the above stated objectives. The North American Russian Communication Association, Inc. shall also develop partnerships and collaboration with organizations that have similar goals and strategies in Russia and other former Soviet states.

Article IV Manner of Election

The Board of Directors of the North American Russian Communication Association, Inc. shall consist of the sitting President of the Russian Communication Association (duly elected by the Russian Communication Association), the Executive Director of the North American Russian Communication Association, Inc., and five at-large Board members. The Executive Director will serve a five (5) year term; other Board members will serve staggered three-year terms (for three Board members) and two year terms (for two board members). The Executive Director and the five initial Board members shall be appointed. Subsequently, the Board will function as a nominating committee to present a slate of candidates for replacement Board members and/or the Executive Director as needed for a vote of the membership present at the annual business meeting of the North American Russian Communication Association, Inc.
