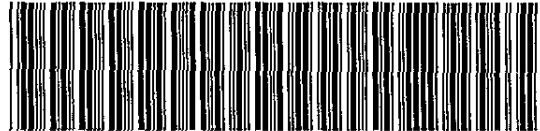

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SISTERS CARING & SHARING -EIN #57-1214912

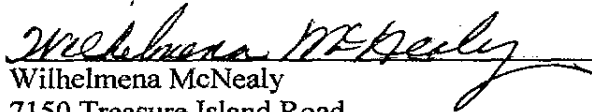
- ARTICLE ONE: The name of the corporation is Sisters Caring & Sharing, Inc. The corporation is organized pursuant to the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code.
- ARTICLE TWO: The principal place of business of the corporation is Lake and Sumter Counties with the mailing address of 7150 Treasure Island Road, Leesburg, Florida 34788.
- ARTICLE THREE: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. The corporation is organized under the Non profit Public Benefit Corporation Law for, charitable and educational purposes to aid the African American Women and Men, promote awareness of good health and early detection in the African American Communities. Also, the purposes are to provide educational and charitable, to aid the poor and disadvantaged individual and families for early detection of breast and prostate, cancer, support to cancer victims, and those in recovery from cancer to a life of self-sufficiency.

ARTICLE SEVEN:

- (a) This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for Educational and Charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to carry on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE EIGHT: On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of all debts, and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for, Educational and Charitable under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government of public purpose. Any such asset not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas in which the principal office of the organization is located, exclusive for such purpose or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
