ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of
1ST FLORIDA REGIMENT YOUNG MARINES, INC.

The undersigned acting as incorporator(s) of a Corporation benefiting minors pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporations. 2005 JUN 22 P 1:21

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: 1st Florida Regiment Young Marines, Inc. and the initial principal Address of the corporation is: 1755 Sweetwater West Circle, Apopka, Florida 32712-2481.

ARTICLE II

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law. Corporate existence shall commence upon filing with the Sec. Of State.

ARTICLE III

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are: The Young Marines Program educates and inspires the youth within our communities by promoting a healthy and drug-free lifestyle through instructional responsible citizens using the volunteer resources of a civilian and military partnership. The Teamwork and esprit-de-corps enjoyed by the Young Marines help them discover the hero within.

ARTICLE IV

The qualifications for members, adult volunteers and the manner of their admission are: The Young Marines are open to all boys and girls ages 8-18 with parentally permission and approval. Adult Volunteers must be at lease 18 years old (with a high school diploma or (GED) or be 21 years and older. Have no felony convictions. Have not received a discharge from the Armed Forces of the United States of America under conditions other than honorable. Have not been a member of an organization listed as subversive by the United States Attorney General's Office. Have not been adjudged insane. Have not been convicted of child abuse or similar offense (s). In addition the volunteer must forward through the local Unit Commander a Registration Packet to the Young Marines National Headquarters for final approval.

ARTICLE V

The street address and city of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1755 Sweetwater West Circle, Apopka, Florida 32712-2481 and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Richard E. Booth.

ARTICLE VI

The Trustees shall be elected by the vote of the registered adult Commanding Officers of the subordinate units within the Regiment. The number of the Trustees consisting the initial Board of Trustees of the corporation is five (5), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are:
