ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION OF SUGARLOAF PALMS ESTATES HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC., a Florida not-for-profit corporation

Pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act (the "Act"), Sugarloaf Palms Estates Homeowners' Association, Inc. ("Association") does hereby adopt the following Articles of Dissolution:

- 1. The dissolution of the Association is authorized under the Act, Section 617.1402, *Florida Statutes*.
 - 2. The dissolution of the Association is in compliance with the Act.
- 3. The Association consists of its Members, all of whom are entitled to vote on a resolution to dissolve the corporate entity.
