**CHARTER OF
THE CHRISTIAN CLERGY ASSOCIATION, INC.**

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be The Christian Clergy Association, Inc. and its location shall be 125 SW 8th Street, Delray Beach, Florida 33444, located in Palm Beach County.

ARTICLE II

The general nature and purpose of this corporation is to inspire harmony and unity in our christian fellowship, to assist ministers through instruction and interpretation of biblical truth and to enhance their God given gifts and their roles in church and community.

The Christian Clergy Association, Inc. is a non-profit organization, under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The membership of the corporation shall be composed of ordained or licensed Ministers of various Christian denominational churches.

Section 1. All licensed Ministers must be recommended by their Pastor or some other member of the organization.

Section 2. A minister living in the area and pastoring out of the area may become a member with all rights, privileges and responsibilities of the organization.

ARTICLE V

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the following officers:

Section 1. The President, who will be the Chairman of the Board of Directors, whose duty shall be to preside over the organization (1) to work to uphold the objectives of the Association (2) to give and to provide directions for the upbuilding of the same (3) appoint all standing committees and to have general oversight over the Association.

Section 1A. The President may appoint such committees that may be deemed necessary for the betterment of the organization, and such committees may function as long as same are needed.

Section 2. The Vice-President's duty shall be to preside in the absence of the President or at such time as the President may direct

Section 3. The Secretary's duties shall be to keep a copy of the constitution of this Association in the files of his book; record the names of all members, showing the church with which they are affiliated; keep a correct record of all proceedings.

Section 4. The Financial Secretary collects and records all monies, turning the same over to the Treasurer; assumes the duties of the Secretary in his absence

Section 5. The Treasurer's duties shall be to receive all monies from the Financial Secretary, to keep records showing the amounts turned over to him by the Financial Secretary; to pay bills on order of the Association; and to submit a detailed report of all monies received and disbursed monthly.

Section 6. The Chaplain's duties shall be to open each meeting with appropriate devotions; dismiss each meeting; and preside over devotional periods at all public services; assume the duties of the Seminar Director in his absence.

Section 7. The Parliamentarian's duties shall be to interpret the articles of the constitution when it is in question, and to settle any method of procedure when it is debated.

Section 8. The Seminar Director's duties shall be to give proper and sound interpretation of the Holy Scriptures and rightly divide the word of truth.

ARTICLE VI

Section 1. All officers shall be elected annually at the last business meeting of each year and shall assume office at the first business meeting of the following year.

ARTICLE VII

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the following officers until the first regular election heretofore provided:

ARTICLE VIII

The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors. This corporation shall have 3 directors initially. The number of directors may be increased from time to time, by the by-laws.

Section 1. The Board of Directors shall be members the corporation

Section 2. Members of the Board of Directors shall be elected and hold office in accordance with the by-laws

Section 3. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as directors for the ensuing year, or until the first annual meeting of the corporation, are:

ARTICLE IX

Section 1. The Board of Directors of this corporation may provide such by-laws for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purposes as they may deem necessary from time to time.

Section 2. Upon proper notice the by-laws may be amended, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of the members of the Board of Directors present at the regular meeting or any special meeting called for that purpose.

ARTICLE X

Section 1. These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at a special meeting of the membership called for that purpose, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those present.

Section 2. Amendments may also be made at a regular meeting of the membership upon notice given, as provided by the by-laws of intention to submit such amendments.

ARTICLE XI

Section 1. The membership fee shall be set annually by the body at the beginning of the year.

Section 2. Two months or more in arrears makes a member non-financial. Upon payment of all back dues, he shall be restored to the organization with all rights and privileges.

ARTICLE XII

The quorum for the body shall be set annually at the beginning of the year.

ARTICLE XIII

The Association shall meet on second Saturdays of each month. The President may call additional meetings at his discretion.

ARTICLE XIV

The constitution shall not be altered or amended, except written notice is given to the members at least thirty (30) days prior to such procedure and then only by two-third vote majority of those present.

ARTICLE XV

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation shall at any time subject itself shall be One Million Dollars, but shall never exceed two-thirds (2/3) the value of the property held by the corporation.

ARTICLE XVI

The corporation shall be entitled to hold real estate of a value not exceeding Two Million Dollars, subject always to the approval of the Board of Directors


