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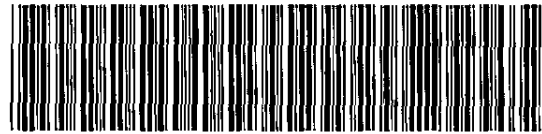

ARTICLE I

NAME OF THE CORPORATION

The name of the corporation shall be CHILD EVANGELISM FELLOWSHIP, INC. OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business of the corporation shall be in the City of St. Petersburg, Florida, at 808 42nd Avenue South, or at such other place or places as may be designated by the County Committee.

ARTICLE III

GENERAL NATURE AND OBJECTS

- (a) Promote and conduct Home Bible Classes for children,
- (b) Foster and carry on open air child evangelism,
- (c) Conduct Bible studies and evangelistic meetings for children in public schools and wherever the opportunity presents itself,
- (d) Conduct conferences for children's workers,
- (e) Procure and disseminate literature on child evangelism and kindred subjects,
- (f) Cooperate with other evangelical christian agencies that are working to teach the word of God to children and to lead them to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ,
- (g) Organize this type of ministry as widely as is possible throughout Pinellas County, Florida.

THE QUALIFICATIONS OF THE MEMBERS OF THIS CORPORATION ARE AS FOLLOWS:

(a) Such person may be either male or female, a resident of Pinellas County, Florida, and a professing Christian.

(b) He or she shall be vitally interested in Christian work among younger children.

(c) Such person shall be of sterling character and reputation.

(d) Each person upon becoming a member shall be required to sign the Statement of Faith now in force in the International Child Evangelism Fellowship.

The members of the corporation shall be admitted and elected by the County Committee in the manner and form provided by the by-laws.

ARTICLE IV

TERM OF EXISTENCE

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual unless it shall be determined by at least a two-thirds vote of the entire membership of the County Committee to dissolve the same.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a County Committee which is composed of all of the above named subscribers. It shall be known as the County Committee of the corporation and shall be nine (9) in number, but the same may be increased at any general or special meeting of the membership or decreased at any general election meeting of the committee. The membership of this committee shall be filled by the members of the corporation in the manner to be provided in the by-laws and shall be elected at a general membership meeting to be held during the last fifteen (15) days of July of each year beginning with the year of 1956. The date and time of such meeting shall be fixed by the President of the corporation and one week's notice be given to the members of such meeting.

ARTICLE VIII BY-LAWS

ARTICLE IX
AMOUNT OF INDEBTEDNESS OR LIABILITY OF THE CORPORATION

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may at any time subject itself, which shall never be greater than two-thirds of the property value of the corporation, shall be Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE X
VALUE OF REAL ESTATE TO BE OWNED BY THE CORPORATION

The amount in value of real estate which the corporation may hold subject always to the approval of the Circuit Court of Pinellas County, Florida shall not exceed Thirty-five Thousand (\$35,000.00) Dollars.

ARTICLE XI
ANNUAL MEETING OF THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE CORPORATION

The annual meeting of the membership of the corporation shall be held during the last two weeks of the month of July of each year beginning with the year 1956. The special order of first business for that meeting shall be election of the members of the County Committee. Such other business may come before such meeting as is permitted under the Laws of Florida, this Charter and the By-Laws. The general membership meeting shall be followed immediately by an organization meeting of the members of the old Committee which shall wind up its affairs and turn the meeting over to the new Committee for election of its officers and the transaction of such new business as shall come before it.


