# **Articles of Incorporation**

of

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SECOND CHANCE OUTREACH PROGRAM, INCLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

## Article I- Name of Corporation

The name of the corporation is SECOND CHANCE OUTREACH PROGRAM, INC,

## Article II- Purpose of this corporation

The corporation is organized pursuant to the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code. The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Federal Tax Code), including the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code). In furtherance of such purposes, the corporation is organized to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ and to seek to meet the spiritual, Financial, charitable and physical needs of the community to the glory of God.

No part of net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Four hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The corporation shall not directly or indirectly participate in, or intervene in (including the publish or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office, to any extent whatsoever.

Not withstanding any other provision of these articles of incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provisions of any future federal tax code), or (b)

by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code). Further notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or excise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation, and shall never be authorized to engage in a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit.

**Section 1:** The Corporation will not have members.
